Passenger Facility Charge

On November 1, 2009 air carriers operating at the Charleston International Airport began collecting a Passenger Facility Charge (PFC) of \$4.50, which was approved by the Authority Board and the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA). The Board's approval was the culmination of a year long study and planning by the Aviation Authority in cooperation with our air carriers and the FAA. PFCs are collected by the air carriers and forwarded to the Authority. The monies collected will be used to fund and support the Authority's renovations of its twenty-five year old terminal facility.
